Blessed with a poor memory from a young age, words and now images are essential to Llinos, to record a world when moments will not endure. Moments in rural and industrial landscapes, city landscapes, people's lives, her life. Small, simple and complex moments.

Nature often gives Llinos more than a helping hand in providing spectacular light and weather to capture images that reflect the feeling of what she sees.

After eight years of Social Work in London and fifteen as a Relationship and Family Therapist, the chance purchase of a camera and an unexpected meeting with some sheep on a hillside soon after, changed Llinos' life. An image of those sheep won a Daily telegraph competition and a commission in Singapore – to capture images for the Singapore Tourist Board Calendar '07.

Llinos won the Photography Award at the 'Welsh Artist of the Year 2010' and was a finalist in 2009. The National Library of Wales invited her to speak at their Lens VI Festival, 'Wales and the World', Novembers 2010.

Trevillion and Millenium Picture Libraries have accepted a number of Llinos' images and five were recently sold for use as book covers in the Netherlands, Spain, England and the U.S.

Llinos is freelance and self taught. She exhibits a collection of photographic prints, creates images for artists, picture libraries, magazines, publishing houses and accepts commissions from individuals, charities and businesses.
